

What to do if your arrow

is still lost at the end of the session.

It is very important that ALL arrows are found – this is a playing field, and we cannot be responsible for any injuries caused by our equipment.

Please ensure that you follow this process to make committee aware of the issue:

- 1. Before your bow is put away, place a flag in the ground at the centre point under the target.**
- 2. Place a flag at your position on the shooting line.**
- 3. Advise the line captain of the direction and orientation of the arrow flight. This is in order to give searchers an idea of where to start looking (High, Left etc).**
- 4. Give as much detail as you can –**
 - i. Arrow colours**
 - ii. Aluminium / Carbon / Wood**
 - iii. Distance being shot**
 - iv. Any issues with the shot.**
- 5. Make arrangements with the line captain to come back next day, if possible, to help with the search.**
