# **Important Info!**

# Do you know what to do if you

#### lose or can't find an arrow?

- Look for your arrow during arrow collection
- Alert fellow archers on the range, they will help!
- If not found on first search make Line Captain aware
- Search again at following arrow collection, Line Captain will encourage volunteers to assist.
- Make it known the colours and details of your missing arrow, try to establish a general direction of its flight.

If an arrow remains unfound, despite everyone's best efforts, then as range is dismantled as many as possible should methodically look for the missing arrow. Keep Committee/coaching members 🌶 aware of situation. We are aware that light and weather conditions are a factor. "LINE CAPTAIN HAS A RECORD OF LOST ARROW SHEET!" THS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE ARCHERS LEAVE SITE

- 1. There should be a flag or two placed to locate the target that was missed, to give direction.
- 2. A KEYHOLDER will make the Rugby club aware of the potential hazard.
- 3. As the arrows owner, you should endeavour to make every effort to find your arrow.
- 4. This could mean turning up and searching again as soon as possible the next day.
- 5. Metal detector and rakes are available
- 6. Keep the Committee/Di and John aware of what is happening
- 7. "Kebab of rugby player" will lose us our venue, so finding a lost arrow or at least ensuring the Rugby club are aware, will ensure we maintain good relations with our landlords
